The Blues got off to an early lead of three runs and held their opponents scoreless until the eighth, when Boyles scored on an error by Underwood. Only two men allowed to cross the initial sack and one of them was forced to remain there. Bridges of Krum struck out eleven men while Rogers of Little Elm fanned five. Reeves ended his season's play by leading the locals in hits, getting four hits out of five trips to the plate. Next Sunday the locals meet their old rival, Sanger on the local diamond.
